COSMOGRAPH DAYTONA OYSTER PERPETUAL WEARING THE WATCH FOR THE FIRST TIME Before being worn for the first time, or if it has stopped, a Rolex watch must be wound manually in order to function correctly and precisely. To wind the watch manually, unscrew the winding crown completely, then turn it several times clockwise.

Important Reminder: It will be necessary to manually wind your newly purchased watch before wearing in order to fully charge the movement and to guarantee that it will run properly. Unscrew the crown to the winding position and turn the crown clockwise approximately 40 times. Don't forget to screw the crown back in tightly before wearing.
